We are disappointed that your level of secrecy, intransigence, and lack of transparency has recently reverted back to your Committee 'going underground' as previously in not supplying agendas, minutes, or meetings for public consumption against good practice for Welsh Community Councils.

Once again, we await your reply, but are informed from repeated discussions with local villagers and several neighbouring committees and councils on the island, that such negativity is often the norm with the Aberffraw Community Council.

We are at a loss to find your preferred means of communication, having tried and suggested person to person, telephone, email, meeting minutes, letters, social media, newsletter, contacting colleagues etc., all to no avail. Why are you incapable/unwilling of communicating with us?
