### **Minutes of Meeting 12<sup>th</sup> August 2020 7pm (via Zoom)**

#### **Minutes of previous meeting Approved**

1. **Matters Arising:** comments from Community Council to our queries
  - a. Yellow lines – nothing happened, no minutes
  - b. Signage to hall – nothing happened, no minutes
  - c. Street lamp – fixed
  - d. Public toilet funding – no reply, no minutes
  - e. RHI funding – no reply, no minutes

Chairman has provided an update of hall contents as Community Council underestimated value. Insured at £6,000 correct value £32,000. Suzanne has forwarded Gillian's email to Community Council, and separately emailed her that she has arranged for an insurance valuer to do a site visit for valuation of building.

2. **Keep Wales Tidy Grant**

Wild garden has arrived and was installed by Gareth Jones from Keep Wales Tidy, Jan and Pete and Mike. Pete and Jan are in the process of organising a watering rota. Pete and Jan to take the lead in organising volunteers for planting of bulbs and wildflower seeds at a future date.

3. **Post Lockdown Opening of Village Hall**

Probable opening of Village Hall 3<sup>rd</sup> September. Hall can be opened for fitness but not social gatherings. Permission is not needed from local council but it is advised. A standard risk assessment plus a Covid assessment needs to be done.
