Communications with Aberffraw Community Council

Finally, after awaiting 14 months for publication of the CC minutes of meetings to find out what has arisen, (including several requests from us for assistance in tracing a boiler fuel grant, street lighting, yellow lines for mobility scooters, insurance, and ideas for funding the public toilet) our Village Hall Committee was astonished to find CC minutes with inaccuracies, omissions, untruths and non-answers.

We have written to the CC on 4 occasions recently, attempted twice to have a joint meeting and as long ago as last autumn tried to fruitfully attend their meetings. We have also attended a Zoom meeting concerning questions to the Village Hall Committee but were refused access to the appropriate minutes. In particular we are concerned with irregularities in their accounts, election procedures, and inaccurate and full reporting of meetings.

Having witnessed continued negativity, obstruction, secrecy, and lack of replies (akin to dealing with a 'Black Hole' where matter enters but does not exit!) we have resorted to contacting other parties and resulted in sending the letter shown opposite with the hope of some positivity and a way around this impasse. (Any positive reader suggestions are very welcome.)

Overall, our aim is for a more fruitful interaction which will enable our committee to keep functioning and for us to keep the Village Hall open for local users and events.

PS: With the help of two local County Councillors and a chance meeting with Council workmen in the street last week by one of our committee, the issues of street lighting and yellow lines have now been solved.

Thank you for ignoring our comments, not replying to our letters, and twice not having an agreed joint meeting. We are particularly dumbfounded that none of your 10 committee members were available for today's meeting. Are you sure that they have all been informed of the previous 3 recent letters and emails we have sent?

Meanwhile, in the absence of engagement by the CC, to move forward, we are currently continuing our discussions both verbally and in writing concerning your accounting irregularities, defamatory comments, omissions, erroneous minutes, elections, lack of transparency, and other matters with:-

1. Your Internal Auditor
2. Your External Auditors (BDO)
3. Anglesey County Council
4. Councillors
5. Aberffraw Villagers

We will in due course inform the local community of the history, details and outcomes in our door to door newsletter 'The Grapevine' and online and provide a report to the Ombudsman.

We are really sorry to again note your committee's negativity in all these matters over the past year, and more so recently, especially when we could all have so easily worked together for the benefit of the community. If you ever do come up with some positive actions or have any dates when your members will attend an arranged joint meeting then please let us know. We must not let all this end up with disagreement resulting in the closure of the Village Hall to the detriment of local people.
